## COTS Chatterbox origami

This activity is designed for students, after-school groups, events, and speaking engagements. Participants can use this as an ice breaker before a talk or as a further reflection following a talk on how to address homelessness in our community.

**INSTRUCTIONS:** Color each COTS square a different color. Cut out the chatterbox, and fold according to instructions. To play, participants first select a color. Open/close the chatterbox as you spell out each letter of the color. Then select a number. Open/close the chatterbox, counting out the selected number. Pick a number again, but this time, open and read the suggestion for how to address homelessness in our community. Discuss in a small group or individually consider this idea.
